



REDWOOD NATIONAL AND STATE PARKS, CALIFORNIA

The seed of a redwood is the same size as that of a tomato, but from it will grow a tree that may be 350 feet tall and can live for more than 500 years. (Some live to be 2,000 years old.) Redwoods have been growing along the coast of northern California for 20 million years, and today they grow nowhere else. This park protects almost half of the redwoods left in the state.
