



WIND CAVE NATIONAL PARK, SOUTH DAKOTA

This park is small, little more than 44 square miles, but it is home to a herd of bison that has never bred with domestic cattle, one of only four such herds in North America. The park also includes the largest mixed-grass natural prairie left, and that is where visitors generally see the bison, though in the summer they stay close to the forests so they can get shade.
